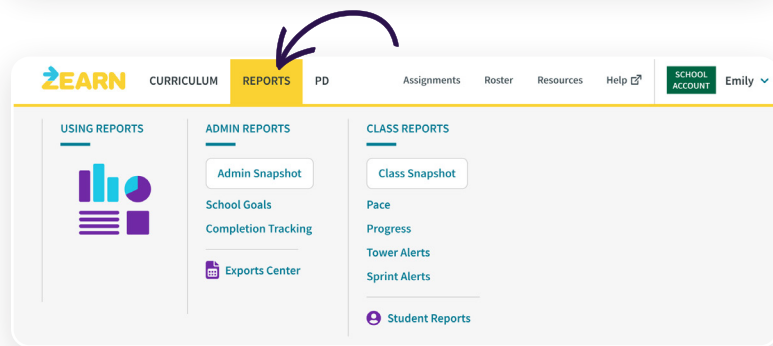
Use the Class Snapshot Report to review important data supporting your Zearn implementation.

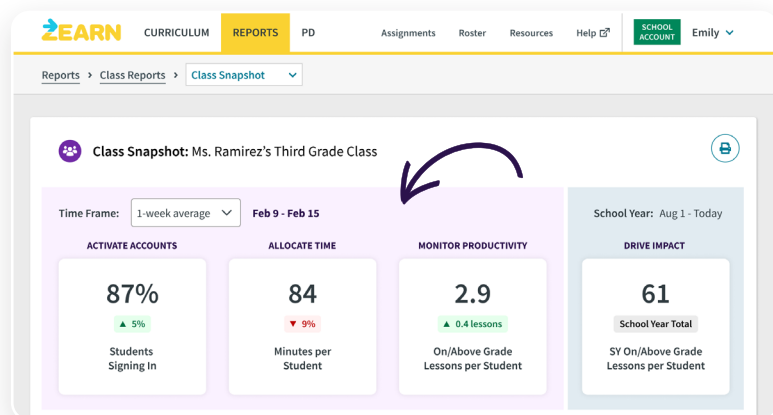

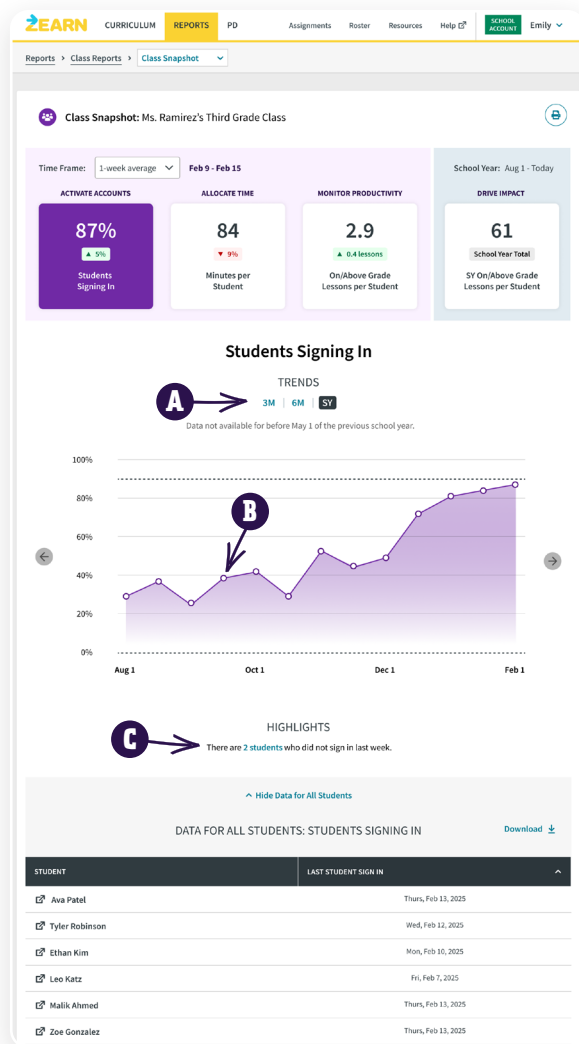

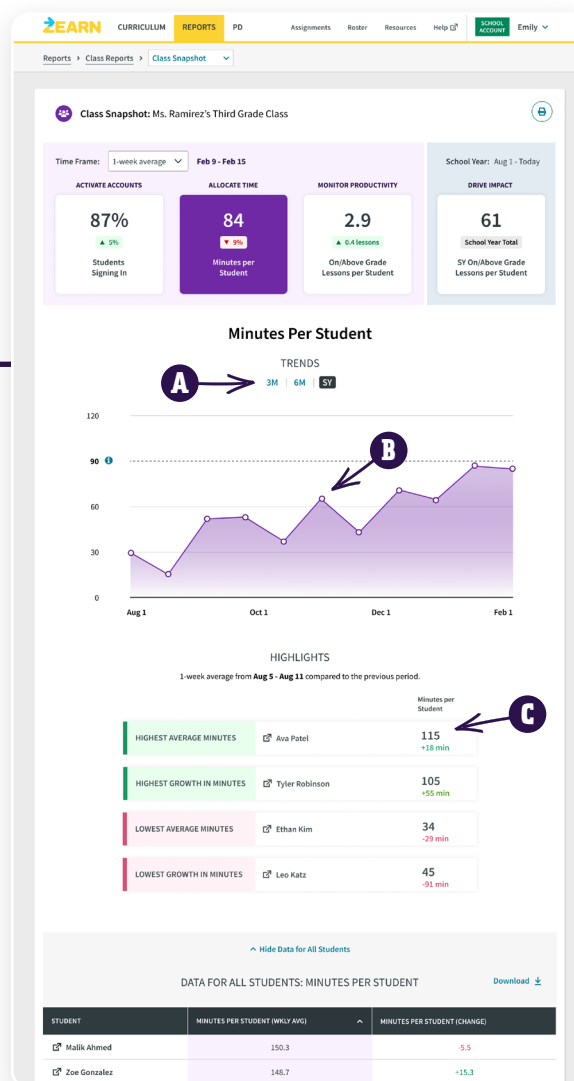

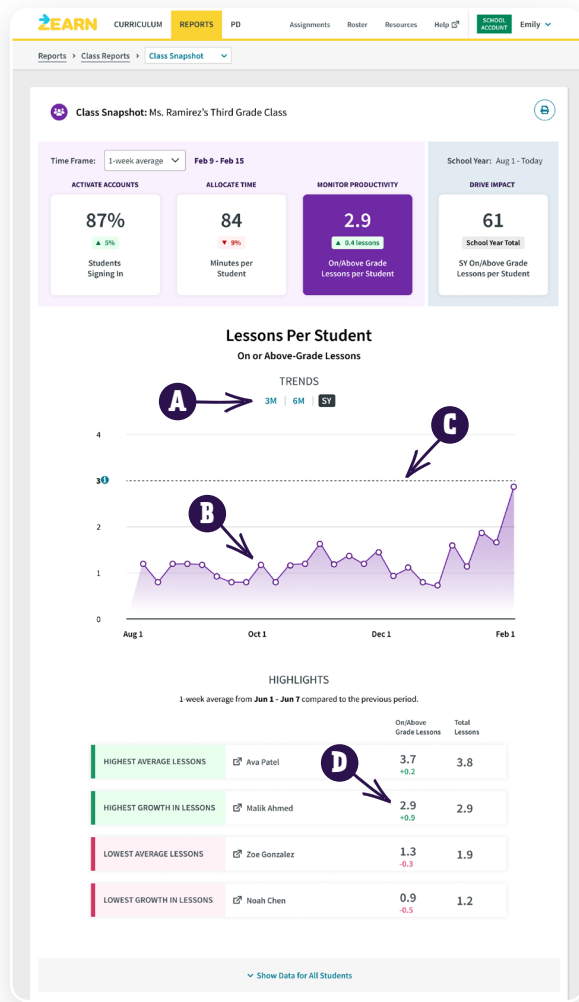

Click **Minutes Per Student** to monitor time spent on Zearn.

- A** Review average minutes per student in a **3 month**, **6 month**, or **school year view**.
- B** Compare minutes achieved to the recommended goal of **90 minutes per week**.
- C** Review students with the highest average minutes, largest increase, lowest average minutes, and largest decrease in the selected time period.

Click **On/Above Grade Lessons per Student** to monitor progress on lesson completion.

- A Review lessons per student in a **3 month**, **6 month**, or **school year view**.
- B Click on a data point to review the percent of students who completed 3+ on/above grade digital lessons.
- C Compare average lessons per student to the recommended goal of 3+ grade-level digital lessons.
- D Review students with the highest average lessons, largest increase, lowest average lessons, and largest decrease in the selected time period.

Click on the metric **SY On/Above Grade Lessons per Student** to monitor progress on completing grade-level digital lessons across the school year.

- A Review the distribution of students based on how many on- or above-grade-level lessons they've completed. Toggle to view total lesson completion instead.
- B Review students with the highest and lowest number of SY lessons in the selected time period.
