


Navigating Spanish-translated Content


Beginning in the 2025-26 school year, teachers with a Zearn School Account can enable students to access K-2 Guided Practice and Tower of Power activities in Spanish. This first phase of Zearn's multi-year rollout of Spanish-translated digital content ensures young learners can receive critical language support from the start. Use this guide to learn how to turn on Spanish content for your students!





Choose Spanish. Confirm student count, then click **Save**. Students will see K-2 Guided Practice and Tower of Power in Spanish by default, with the option to switch to English as needed.


Confirm the Language Setting by clicking “OK”.


On the Roster page, you will now see a new column showing which students have Spanish access. K-2 Guided Practice and Towers will default to Spanish, but students will have the option to switch to English when needed.

II. Student Access to Language Preferences

Once enabled, students will see Spanish in their next K–2 Guided Practice or Tower of Power. If a student is currently working in a Guided Practice or Tower when Spanish is enabled, the view will update after the page refreshes or when they move forward (e.g., to the next Math Chat question).

Students can switch languages at any time by clicking “**See in English**” / “**Ver en español**” and confirming. Their progress is saved. This flexible design allows students to engage with math in Spanish while continuing to access key terms and concepts in English, supporting comprehension and ongoing learning.
